There is very little published literature on badges in college and university libraries, though many libraries have launched or are designing a badge project. [Portland State](#) has published on their badging project.

Ideally, students can make their earned badges public, through Mozilla Backpack. Lots of potential for embedding earned badges into portfolios and LinkedIn profiles. May have implications for gaining an edge with future employers.

Badge Infrastructure Options

[Wordpress Site with Badges OS plugin](#)

- Easy option. I know Wordpress and can make this work. I need a stable server and FTP access.

[Titanium \(Moodle\)](#)

- allows awarding badges, allows students to link to Mozilla Backpack
- [Awarding Badges in Moodle](#) – Campus Technology

[Credly](#)

- Sends badges by email
 - I don't like that it's not seamless
- Built on Mozilla Open Badges system/API
- Plays nice with Mozilla Backpack
- Offers [plugins for Moodle](#) (Titanium)
 - Provides a block that can display a user's earned badges.
 - A simple management UI that can create and update badges hosted on credly.
 - Provides ability to grant a badge to a user
- Can design badges with Credly
- Wordpress plugins (above)

[Purdue Passport](#)

- I requested and received access to Beta
- Plays nice with Mozilla Backpack, very Purdue-oriented otherwise, been in Beta for years
- Can design badges internally
- Closed system housed at Purdue, works well with Purdue resources, would work well for testing concepts but I'd be hesitant to use another university's proprietary system.

- Open, well-used software for badges. Anything we use should be on this standard.

Academic Libraries that Offer Badges

Portland State University Libraries

- [Badge it!](#) – published article, 2015
- IL badges for Public Health students
- Piloted Fall 2014, a year+ in planning phase
- 11 faculty/staff on the project
- \$20,000 in funding
- Based in D2L; Badges awarded through Credly
 - Badges Offered
 - [Credly Crown](#) – the onboarding badge
 - [Web Ninja](#) – certifies website evaluation
 - [Source Sleuth](#) – certifies understanding of information formats and audiences
 - [Keyword Hacker](#) – certifies search techniques
 - [Recorder](#) – certifies citation style
 - [Silver Pen](#) – certifies a peer review and writing exercise
 - [Master Info Analyzer](#) – culminating badge certifies completion of all badges and passing grade in the class.

University of Iowa Libraries

- Based on Purdue Passport
- Awards free print credits

University of Central Florida Libraries

- Automated using quizzes; 80% score generates email link to Credly badge
- Badges awarded through Credly
- Three categories of tutorials: Gather, Evaluate, and Use

- Some badges issues in Engineering dept for co-curricular learning.
- Uses Mozilla Backpack and Credly
- Manual review of submitted evidence

[Texas Wesleyan University – Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning](#)

- Awards badges for professional development for faculty/staff
- Earn badges for attending events, completing challenges
- Badges issued through Credly
- Pedagogy map
- “Not everybody was really that excited about the leaderboard and competing with their peers to complete professional development.” And the awarding of badges seemed to some people like it was juvenile,” Pope said.’ [From this article](#).

- Overall badges = Master Evaluator, Digital Citizen, Producer & Collaborator, Empowered Learner (complete all and you get a metaliteracy badge)
- WordPress site with the [Badges OS plugin](#) – works with Credly!
 - TwentyTwelve Theme (housed on LearningTimes site)
- Sends students on “quests”
